When and Where

Tour takes place Sunday, August 15, 2010. You may start anytime between the hours of 7:00am and 12:00 noon (CDT). All riders must be off the routes by 3:30pm CDT. The departure and finishing point for all four routes is the Rolling Prairie Elementary School, located on east Michigan Street in Rolling Prairie, Indiana

Routes

Routes are 25, 40, 62 and 100 miles. The Routes go past small communities, farms, rural homes, orchards, woods and lakes. These routes can be ridden in any combination also. There are hills present on the Longer rides, be a good challenge!

Pre-Registration

The Pre-registration fee is \$12.00, with letter postmarked no later than August 7, 2010.

Day of Ride Registration

Day of ride cost is \$18.00. Registration will be conducted until 12:00 noon.

Family Registration

Special pre- and day of registration fee for families of 3 or more is \$30. A family consists of parents and their children only. Children under 8 and under are free.

Assistance

All registrants receive a map with route guide information, as well as snacks and drinks at all sag stops. Marked vehicles will patrol the route to assist those riders with breakdown problems. Please make sure your bicycle is in good working order.

Safety

Please obey all traffic laws and regulations. Riders should wear bright clothing for general visibility and safety. Safety helmets are strongly recommended. Riders should make provisions for day-of-tour weather conditions.

Camping

Free tent camping will be available at Rolling Timbers Campground which is located on Hwy 2. Indicate on your application your interest in camping. We will call to verify.
